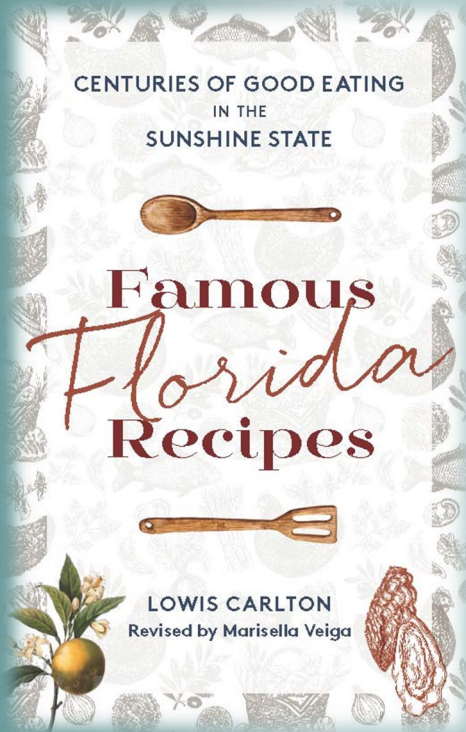


# The Writers' Talks at Marjorie Kinnan Rawlings Historic State Park
